Points to Ponder

- 1. Consider how Jesus had complete control over His entrance into Jerusalem with the exact choosing of the donkey. Jesus is directing all events including where and how a donkey is tied up. How does the fact that Jesus is completely in control over all things concerning your life affect you and influence the way you think, pray and act?
- 2. Think of the significance of what Jesus is saying, "If the disciples did not cry out then creation would!" In essence, Jesus is saying rather emphatically that 'inanimate objects', rocks, have a better perception of what God is doing than do the people that Jesus came to save! How perceptive are you to what God is doing right now?
