### Points to Ponder

1. Consider Paul's statement how God permitted all nations to go their own ways and yet left them with a witness of His goodness and provision (14:16). How did God still look after you before you knew Him? How is He continuing to look after you now?
2. Who do you worship? The God who has revealed Himself through His Word or the god of your own imagination? Ask the Lord to help you see areas in your life where your worship is not where it should be.
